

Young Member Fact Sheet

Who Can Apply?

You can apply to become the SA Youth Week 2018 Young Member if you are aged between 18-25 years and live in South Australia.

What does the Young Member do?

The Young Member is the official ambassador for SA Youth Week 2018, which will be held from 13-22 April 2018. The Young Member is expected to contribute their ideas to the State Government, and is involved in decision-making and activities that will assist in the planning, promotion, running and evaluation of SA Youth Week. During SA Youth Week the Young Member will attend events across South Australia, and act as media spokesperson to promote events.

Is it a paid position?

No, however a \$10 per hour honorarium will be provided for involvement in approved SA Youth Week activities.

What will be involved?

The Young Member will be required to:

- assist, plan, promote, run and evaluate SA Youth Week
- attend an induction session with staff from the Community Services Division, Department for Communities and Social Inclusion
- act as the media spokesperson* for SA Youth Week
- attend SA Youth Week events across South Australia
- travel to metropolitan and regional areas within South Australia as required
- manage the SA Youth Week Facebook page
- communicate regularly with the Community Services Division and stakeholders.

When would the position commence?

The Young Member role will commence from October 2017 and finish in May 2018.

What support will I receive?

The Young Member will be provided with:

- information and support
- honorarium payments of \$10 per hour for involvement in SA Youth Week activities
- a letter of recognition outlining your involvement in SA Youth Week

How do I apply?

Special Conditions

The successful applicant will be required to undergo a satisfactory Background Screening and National Criminal History Record Check (NCHRC) prior to commencing the Young Member role.
